

PEACE PAMPHLET

"For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross" (Colossians 1:19-20).

It could be said that the motive of every religion is to be in right relationship with the divine, to be at peace vertically. But as with horizontal relationships, peace is not possible if it depends on fallen people. Rather than demanding continual animal sacrifices from us, God made a way for right relationship with Him by offering His Son's life and blood for us. The cross is our relational reconciliation to God.

TUE	Meditate on what it cost God to extend peace to you.
WED	Consider and confess any sin that's hindering your worship or prayer life.
